To communicate our brand, we need to create, deploy and consistently maintain many elements.

These include our name, logo, strapline, colour palette, typography and imagery.

These elements form the basis of our brand identity.

Our logo

The logo consists of the Build UK name, the 'flag' and the strapline. This is a unique piece of artwork that has been designed specifically for our brand.

It is our primary brand identifier and where possible it must appear in every Build UK communication.

Never, under any circumstances, should the logo artwork be altered or re-created. Only use the approved files when reproducing and applying the Build UK brand.

It is not permissible to use the text of the logo without the 'flag' but the 'flag' may be used on its own as a signature or decorative device.

There is a mono version of the logo which is permissible in instances where only one colour is available, but this version of the logo should only ever be used when such restrictions apply. Every effort should be made to reproduce the colour version of the logo in the first instance.

There is a reversed version of the logo for use specifically on darker colour and photographic backgrounds.

Exclusion zone restrictions

The Build UK logo should always be surrounded by a generous field of clear space to ensure its legibility and impact on the page. This isolates the logo and protects it from competing visual elements such as text and supporting graphics.

The minimum amount of space that should surround the logo in any application is equal to the size of the “B” in the Build UK logo.

It is permissible to place either the positive or reversed version of the logo over a background image, see examples on page 6.

Minimum size usage

At extremely small sizes, the readability of the logo becomes compromised due to the size of the strapline text. To ensure that the logo is always legible, it should never be reproduced in its full form any smaller than **35mm** in width.

Mini logo (small use only)

There is a mini logo which can be used in extreme cases where reproduction is required on very small items such as pens and the strapline would not be legible (**i.e. below 35mm logo width and no smaller than 20mm**).

This is shown here and should only ever be used in extreme cases.

Never, under any circumstances, should the logo artwork be altered or re-created.

Only use the approved files when reproducing and applying the Build UK brand.

Build UK has three types of member logo:

- Contractor Member
- Trade Association Member
- Specialist Contractor

Organisations may only use (display) the logo that defines their membership status. They must never redraw or attempt to alter these logos in any way. They may display the appropriate logo on any communication or promotional materials including vehicle liveries and clothing.

Our typography

Typography is another essential piece of the Build UK identity system. The consistent use of the selected typeface families throughout Build UK applications must be adhered to in order to maintain the integrity of the brand.

Proxima Nova has been chosen as the Build UK font. It has become a popular web font due to its modern proportions and geometric appearance. The overall family consists of 48 fonts (eight weights in three width with italics) and is readily available.

Lucida Sans has been selected as the Build UK in-house font. This should be used for (but not limited to) letter writing, presentations and emails where Proxima Nova is not available.

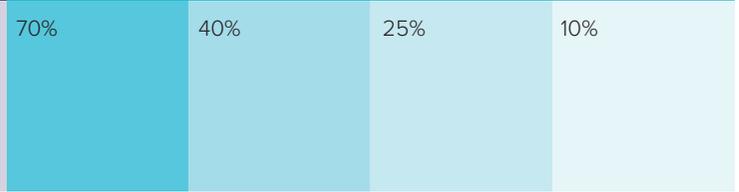
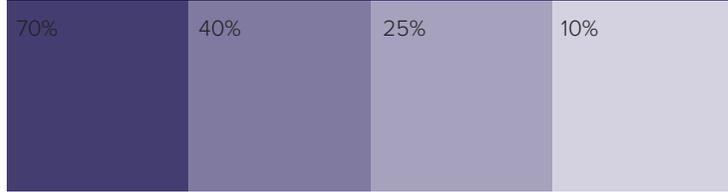

These colours must not be used for anything other than supporting the communication of the issues they relate to. Three further colours are approved for use on any other materials.

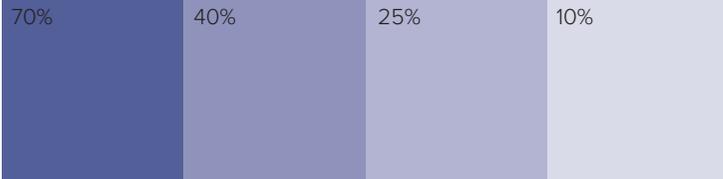
