

Accident Survey Report 2023/2024

Introduction

Build UK members are committed to reducing the fatal, specified and over-7-day injury incidence rates within the construction industry, and we collate information from our Contractor members every year on accidents reportable under RIDDOR.

This report summarises information from Build UK Tier One Contractor members for the period 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024.

Build UK had 21 such members during this period and all of them have provided information. Collectively they had 195,746 operatives: 34% (66,609) were direct employees and 66% (129,156) were sub-contractors.
