

CITB funding aims to help industry address the skills gap in construction

We invest in projects aligned to our three priorities

- Careers
- Innovation
- Training & Development

Funding priorities

To make sure our funding really benefits industry and addresses our priorities, we allocate funding based on a project's impact and outcomes

## £5m CITB Funding

#### Small employer delivery of training

- Available to CITB-registered employers with:
  - Up to 49 staff (£5,000)
  - Up to 74 staff (£7,500)
  - Up to 99 staff (£10,000)
- Aligned to Grant Rules (construction themed training)

Application windows open monthly

Average 150 applications per month





### **CITB** Funding

### Funding for problems identified by industry

- £4m available in 2019-20
- We invest into priority areas:
  - Innovation
  - Training & development
- Up to £500,000 per project, 70% of the value

### Who can apply

- Projects must include three or more:
  - CITB-registered employers
  - Construction Federation / Trade Association
  - CITB-approved Training Group



10,000 individuals will benefit from receiving onsite experience


7,300 individuals will become employment and site ready
