'Standards' replacing 'Frameworks'



New 'Standards'

- 'Occupational' focus rather than 'qualification' focus.
- Will replace frameworks over time.
- End point assessment used to demonstrate competency.
- 20% 'off the job' is a key element of standards.

20% off the job

- One of the essential components of a quality apprenticeship.
- Minimum amount of time to be spent on occupational 'off the job' training.
- Clear definition from ESFA.

- A knowledge test.
- Oral questioning (supported by portfolio).

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Digital Apprenticeship Service


CITB Apprenticeships Team is able to support you with managing your Digital Account.

The rollout of Digital Accounts to all employers is expected in April 2020.

The Apprenticeship Service – Levy Transfer

- Apprentices who currently pay the Apprentice Levy can transfer up to 25% of their levy to Non Apprenticeship levy Employers.
- Funds can be transferred to as many Employers as they chose, but only for Apprenticeship standards.
- Transferred funds can only be used for new starts, not existing apprentices.
