How can I get involved?

Idea 1: You can tune in via Skype, YouTube, or FaceTime.

We suggest you get in touch with your site as soon as possible and confirm the platform that suits you best.

Idea 2: Use these films to stimulate discussion!

How do I tune in via Skype?

- 1. <u>Set up an account</u>: If you don't already have an account, follow <u>this link</u> to set up an account.
- 2. <u>Add the site as a contact</u>: Your site manager will have contacted you to tell you their Skype username and the date and time of the site viewing.
- 3. **Download Skype**: follow this link and all the steps on the installer.
 - a. <u>Windows/Mac OS</u>: If you wish to use a computer, follow the relevant link on the website.
 - b. <u>Mobile Phone</u>: If you wish to use a mobile phone, follow the mobile phone link for which type of mobile phone you have (Apple or Android).
- 4. <u>Call the person</u>: At the nominated time, select the 'new chat' button and enter the username you received from above. Then select the video call button to initiate the call.
 - a. <u>Accept the call</u>: However, if the caller has called you first, you will need to accept the call by clicking the green 'accept call' button.

How do I tune in via FaceTime?

- 1. <u>Make note of your time</u>: Your site manager will have contacted you to tell you their number (or Apple ID) and the date and time of the site viewing.
- 2. **Open the FaceTime app**: Select the FaceTime app from your homepage.
- Sign in: Use your Apple ID to sign in. FaceTime automatically registers your phone number should you have one on your device. Alternatively, for iPad and iPod touch users, you can sign in using your email address by navigating to settings → FaceTime → Use your Apple ID for Facetime → sign in with your Apple ID.
- 4. <u>Making the call</u>: Type the person's phone number or email address from above and then select the video button.
 - a. <u>Accepting a call</u>: However, if the caller has called you first, accept the call by clicking the green 'accept call' button.

How do I tune in via YouTube?

- 1. <u>Check your email</u>: Your site manager will inform you that their site tour will be uploaded to YouTube.
- Live or pre-recorded? The next steps depend on whether the video will be live or pre-recorded:
 - a. <u>Pre-recorded</u>: Your site manager will send you a link once the video has been uploaded. Follow this link to watch the video.
 - b. <u>Live</u>: If the tour will be streamed live, the site manager will send you an email with a channel name and what time and date the video will be made live. At the designated time, visit the channel and click their video.
