

What product markings will be recognised from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2022?

On 1 January 2021, the requirements on product markings in the UK changed with the introduction of a new UK Conformity Assessed Mark (UKCA). From 1 January 2023, new provisions will apply, whereby products placed on the market in Great Britain must bear the UKCA Mark. Different rules will apply in Northern Ireland from this date.

There are three different marks in circulation:

- **CE** – The European Union and European Economic Area (EEA) marking for product conformity
- **UKCA** – The UK Conformity Assessed mark
- **CE & UKNI** – The Northern Ireland mark which will always be accompanied by the CE mark

This simple guide shows which mark is **currently** acceptable in each location.
