

Accident Survey Report 2021/2022

Introduction

Build UK members are committed to reducing the fatal, specified and over-7-day injury incidence rates within the construction industry, and we collate information from our Contractor members every year on accidents reportable under RIDDOR.

This report summarises information from Build UK Contractor members for the period 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022.

Build UK had **35 Contractor members** during this period and all of them have provided information. Collectively they have 208,802 operatives: 41.4% (86,481) were direct employees and 58.6% (122,321) were sub-contractors.
