

## Accident Survey Report 2022/2023

### Introduction

Build UK members are committed to reducing the fatal, specified and over-7-day injury incidence rates within the construction industry, and we collate information from our Contractor members every year on accidents reportable under [RIDDOR](#).

This report summarises information from Build UK Tier One Contractor members for the period **1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023**.

Build UK had 24 such members during this period and all of them have provided information. Collectively they have 178,122 operatives: 37% (66,174) were direct employees and 63% (111,948) were sub-contractors.
