

Accident Survey Report 2023/2024

Introduction

Build UK members are committed to reducing the fatal, specified and over-7-day injury incidence rates within the construction industry, and we collate information from our Contractor members every year on accidents reportable under [RIDDOR](#).

This report summarises information from Build UK Tier One Contractor members for the period **1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024**.

Build UK had 21 such members during this period and all of them have provided information. Collectively they had 195,746 operatives: 34% (66,609) were direct employees and 66% (129,156) were sub-contractors.
